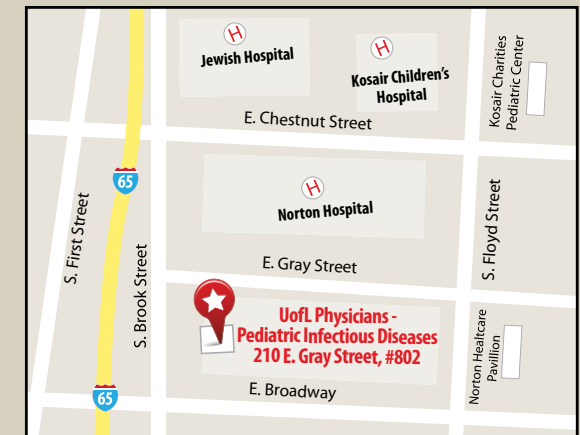

FROM I-65 SOUTH

Take the Jefferson Street Exit #136C and stay right and merge onto JEFFERSON STREET.

FROM I-65 NORTH

Take the Chestnut Street/Broadway Exit #136A and merge onto BROOK STREET and stay RIGHT.

Go 1 block to GRAY STREET and turn RIGHT.

The Gray Street Building is on your right.
